

## SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the year 2024 (the "2024 Appropriation Ordinance") of the City of Chicago (the "City") contains estimates of revenues receivable as grants from agencies of the state and federal governments and public and private agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Office of the Mayor has been awarded private grant funds in the amount of \$75,000 by Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund, Inc. for the CityStart Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Office of Budget and Management has been awarded public grant funds in the amount of \$70,000,000 by the County of Cook for the Disaster Response and Recovery Fund program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Cultural Affairs and Special Events has been awarded state grant funds in the amount of \$450,000 by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for the Tourism and Hospitality Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Family and Support Services has been awarded additional state grant funds in the amount of \$372,000 by the Illinois Department on Aging for the Area Plan on Aging program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of the Environment has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$2,208,000 by the United States Department of Energy for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Streets and Sanitation has been awarded federal pass-through grant funds in the amount of \$3,000,000 by The Morton Arboretum for the Illinois Urban and Community Forestry program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Transportation has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$2,000,000 by the United States Department of Transportation as part of the Reconnecting Communities and Neighborhoods Grant program; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The amount of \$78,105,000 is hereby appropriated from Fund 925 - Grant Funds for the year 2024. The 2024 Annual Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended by striking the words and figures and adding the words and figures indicated in the attached Exhibit A which is hereby made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2.** To the extent that any ordinance, resolution, rule, order or provision of the Municipal Code of Chicago, or part thereof, is in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall control. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
