WHEREAS, Roberto Tañón has been an unwavering pillar of the community, supporting local little league teams, adult fast-pitch softball, artists, musicians, and various community residents, while generously contributing to local community organizations; and

WHEREAS, Roberto Tañón's commitment extends beyond business success, as he actively imparts inspiration and guidance to aspiring entrepreneurs, sharing insights to help cultivate and nurture the next generation of successful Puerto Rican-owned enterprises;

WHEREAS, La Bruquena and its owners have served as an enduring source of pride and inspiration to Chicago's Puerto Rican community, exemplifying the values of hard work, quality service, and perseverance in the face of adversity;
