ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 2-80-040 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, which allows for erection of honorary street designations, the Commissioner of the Chicago Department of Transportation shall take the necessary action for the Standardization of Jarvis Avenue between Greenview Avenue and Sheridan Avenue as "Honorary Don Selle Way."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

Upon passage of this designation ordnance, pursuant to Section 2-8-040 of the Chicago Municipal Code.


